E82/08 DECLARATION OF PERSONAL OR PREJUDICIAL INTEREST

E83/08 ANNUAL COST OF THE BROADBAND LINE FOR CORONATION PARK

Councillors C McMahon read out an appeal from RMBC to Maltby Town Council for assistance in paying the annual cost of broadband for the CCTV cameras in Coronation Park.

RECOMMENDED: that the Acting Clerk obtain more details.

E84/08 SUMMER PLANTING

There were three quotations on the table from 3 local businesses. The quotes were considered and a proposal made by Councillor C McMahon and seconded by Councillor Mr K F Stringer.

RECOMMENDED: A) to use Hobson for a reduced planting scheme b) that we use the money saved on the hanging baskets to provide additional fixed planting within the town subject to permission from RMBC where required c) that a co-ordinated planting scheme be drafted and presented for consideration by the committee and d) the quotes to be tabled at the April Town Council meeting.

VOTE: FOR 2 AGAINST 2

The chairman used his casting vote and the motion was passed.

E85/08 ALLOTMENT SITES

Councillor A D Foster was anxious that the purchase of temporary fencing for Milton Street was not being progressed. He stated that he will check how many fencing panels are required and report back.

RECOMMENDED: that the above be noted.


E86/08 EXCHANGE OF INFORMATION
